You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

1. What is this product?

Objectives

The product is designed to provide (1) a return in the form of fixed rate interest payments and (2) repayment of the **product notional amount** on termination of the product. The **product notional amount** will be repaid either (a) on the **maturity date** or (b) if we exercise our option to terminate the product prior to the **maturity date**, on the relevant **call payment date**. The product has a fixed term and will terminate on the **maturity date**, unless terminated early.

Early termination following a call: We have the right, exercisable on each call exercise date, to terminate the product. In this case, the product will terminate and you will on the immediately following call payment date receive, in addition to a final interest payment, a cash payment equal to the call payment of USD 2,000.00. No interest payments will be made after such call payment date. The relevant dates are shown in the table below.

Termination on the maturity date: If the product has not terminated early, on the maturity date you will receive USD 2,000.00.

Under the product terms, certain dates specified above and below will be adjusted if the respective date is either not a business day or not a trading day (as applicable). Any adjustments may affect the return, if any, you receive.

The product terms also provide that if certain exceptional events occur (1) adjustments may be made to the product and/or (2) the product issuer may terminate the product early. These events are specified in the product terms and principally relate to the product and the product issuer. The costs shown in the table above represent how much the expected costs of the product would affect your return, assuming the product performs in line with the moderate performance scenario. Disregarding the impact on your return in that scenario, the estimated entry and exit costs as a percentage of the **product notional amount** are estimated to be 5.28% if you cash in after year 1, 5.28% if you cash in after 4 years and 4.28% if you cash in after the recommended holding period.

5. How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

Recommended holding period: 7 years

The product aims to provide you with the return described under "1. What is this product?" above. However, this only applies if the product is held to maturity. It is therefore recommended that the product is held until 31 July 2026 (maturity).
