This notice is addressed to the investors of the “Up to Euro 18,000,000 of HSBC Emerging Currencies Linked Notes due June 2015” (ISIN code XS0505429802) (the “Notes”) that on 27 May 2010 and on 8 June 2010 HSBC Bank plc published two supplements to the Base Prospectus by filing them with the United Kingdom Financial Services Authority. The supplements have been published in Italy pursuant to Article 11, paragraph 3 of Consob Regulation No. 11971 dated 14 May 1999 as subsequently amended.

Investors who have already agreed to purchase or subscribe for the Notes shall have the right, pursuant to Article 95 bis, paragraph 2 of Legislative Decree No. 58 of 1998, to withdraw their acceptances within two working days after the publication of this notice, and in particular within close of business on 15 June 2010.
